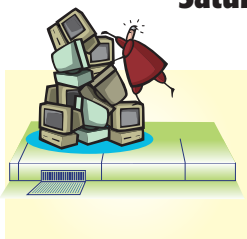




E-Waste Curbside Pickup Event

Saturday, March 20th



Your Local Boy Scout Troops Request the Following:

Please **DO NOT** set out your e-waste earlier in the week, since e-waste collection will not take place until Saturday, March 20th. Place your items curbside by 8am.

Registration is not required for this event. There are two exceptions:

- ✓ If you have a large TV that is over 40", please call the NRWS/NCRWS office at 255-5200 to arrange for special pickup. Deadline for requests is March 17th.
- ✓ If you have Pentium 4, fast Celeron or newer computers and peripherals (working or non-working), please email the Napa Valley Computers to Schools program at info@nvcts.org for reuse options.

Please follow the guidelines for what is acceptable. Boy Scouts will only pick up items listed below.

A voluntary donation of \$10.00 per large e-waste item is suggested and appreciated (but not required).

Boy Scouts will come to your door. Please leave a check made out to "Napa Valley District Boy Scouts" in an envelope at your door.



Please do not leave money on the e-waste!

E-Waste Includes:

COMPUTER EQUIPMENT: computers, modems, keyboards, printers, scanners, cables, & mice.

TELEVISIONS, COMPUTER MONITORS & FLAT SCREENS

OFFICE EQUIPMENT: telephones, fax machines, & copiers.

Please remove toner and recycle separately.

CONSUMER ELECTRONICS: VCRs, tape players, stereo equipment, radios, cell phones, VHS tapes & CDs, etc.

HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES: microwaves, blenders, food processors, toasters, vacuums, coffee makers, etc.
