can cause clogged sewer lines, leading to sewage overflows that contaminate our homes, streets, and creeks. Helping to prevent sewer overflows and back-ups is easy. Just follow these tips below!

- Never pour fat, oil or grease down the drain.
- Don't put food scraps down the garbage disposal.
- Collect fat and grease in a compostable container and dispose of them in the compost pail.
- Wipe greasy pots and pans with paper towels before washing, and then put the paper towels in the compost pail.
- Scrape food scraps into the compost pail.
- Recycle your cooking oil through Napa's free curbside **RECYCLE MORE** program!
