CLEANUP SITES:

- **South Wetland Area** – end of S. Jefferson St.
- **Napa Creek** – corner of Main and Pearl Streets, next to Napa Creek
- **Oxbow District** – north end market parking lot next to the river
- **Kennedy Park** – boat launch parking lot, Streblov Dr.
- **Salvador Creek** – Vintage High School, quad by gym
- **Riverside Drive** – Napa Main Library

- Volunteering is easy! Just pick a site that works for you, and check in with the site captain for further instructions!
- We encourage you to BYO bucket, gloves and reusable water bottle if available. Buckets, bags, and latex gloves will otherwise be provided.
- Wear sunscreen, closed-toe shoes and clothes that you are willing to get dirty.
