
FLUORESCENT LAMP RECYCLING/DISPOSAL FOR BUSINESSES

WHAT IS HAZARDOUS ABOUT FLUORESCENT LAMPS? Fluorescent lamps contain mercury vapor, a toxic, substance that can affect the central nervous system and accumulate in the environment. When a lamp is broken, much of the mercury is dispersed into the air. Fluorescent lamps come in many shapes and sizes including: 4 foot, 8 foot, U-tube, circline and compact fluorescent lamps. High intensity discharge (HID) lamps are often encountered in security and outdoor lighting applications, as well as in high ceiling work areas such as warehouses and supermarkets.

DISPOSAL: Fluorescent lamps and other mercury products, as well as PCB-ballasts, can be disposed of at the Napa-Vallejo Waste Management Authority Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility (businesses must make an appointment and pay a fee). In addition, some of the businesses listed below provide PPRS (pre-paid return service) for all kinds of fluorescent lamps. This type of service usually includes: containers to collect spent bulbs – containers come in many sizes to accommodate different sized bulbs and tubes; pre-paid return address labels; waste pick-up – usually UPS or FedEx mail back; recycling cost; and certificate of reclamation.
