


COLLECTION SERVIC

We provide weekly residential curbside collection services. All carts and service for recycling, compost and landfill/trash is included in one rate. Rates are determined by the size of your landfill/trash cart.

- > Carts must be placed curbside by 6 AM on your service day.
- > Items outside the cart will not be picked up unless you call ahead (fees apply for extra service)
- > No hazardous waste (see p. 12)
- > Carts should not obstruct bike lanes or sidewalks.
- > Place your carts two feet apart and 4-6 feet from any obstruction, such as cars, trees or mailboxes.
- > Did we miss a pickup? Call within 24 hours of a missed pick up and we'll schedule a time to come back.

COMPOST

Food composting is now mandatory
— please include food and soiled
paper in your **brown** or **green**compost cart!

Our customers are entitled to two brown or green compost carts at no charge. Additional carts are available for a small charge.



ALL food & paper based materials can be composted;

- Napkins, paper towels, tissues & other soiled paper
- ☑ Paper cups & plates
- ✓ Coffee filters & tea bags
- ✓ Wax paper, butcher paper & waxed cardboard
- Paper takeout boxes & containers
- ☑ Paper egg cartons

✓ Greasy pizza boxes & paper bags

Loose items outside the cart cannot be picked up and only NRWS carts will be serviced. You may also stop by our Napa office to pick up one box of compostable bags for extra yard trimmings. An extra pickup for yard trimmings may be scheduled twice a year. Please call ahead to request your extra pickup (which will occur on your regular service day).



LANDFILL

You can save money on your garbage bill by reducing your waste. Your rate is determined by the size of your gray landfill cart; 20, 35, 65 or 95 gallon. Please put only non-recyclable, non-compostable items in the gray landfill cart. See below what items go in your landfill cart.

RECYCLE MORE

The Recycle More program offers FREE curbside pickup of e-waste, metal appliances/large metal items, bagged clothing & shoes, batteries, fluorescent bulbs/tubes, and cooking oil.



We collect many items for recycling in addition to what you can put in your recycling cart. Visit naparecycling.com/recycle-more/ to fill out a Pickup Request Form to schedule your free pickup.

Please do not put any of these items in your blue recycling cart. Recycle More curbside pickups are by appointment only.

HOW IT WORKS

ACCEPTED ITEMS

- Consumer electronic waste
- Anything with a cord or battery
- All appliances
- ✓ Oversize metal items (Over 36")
- Household fluorescent bulbs and tubes
- Bagged clothing & shoes (Holes, tears and stains are OK but items must dry and bagged. Wet items cannot be accepted.)
- Cooking oil

 (Call or go online to request a collection container.)
- Bagged household batteries (When combined with another Recycle More item.)



FLUORESCENT W **BULBS AND TUBES**

Must be placed in a box for pickup — no loose bulbs or tubes. Contact us below or at 707-255-5200 if you need a box for your tubes. Tubes over 4' must be brought to the Hazardous Waste Facility.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

Improper and illegal disposal can contaminate our drinking water, impede waste water treatment plants, pollute local waterways and endanger wildlife. It can also lead to penalties and fines. The Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility is for the safe and legal disposal of unusable hazardous products. Please remember to pack products carefully so they won't mix or spill. The facility accepts all types of hazardous waste except:

NO RADIOACTIVES * NO EXPLOSIVES * NO AMMUNITION

HAZARDOUS WASTE INCLUDES:

- METAL: Air compressors, barometers, CO2 cylinders and cartridges, fire extinguishers, helium, and propane
- CONSTRUCTION: Asbestos, electrical switches & relays, fluorescent ballasts, freon, paint, paint thinners, painted wood, treated wood
- MEDICAL: Inhalers, medicine, needles and sharps, oxygen tanks, thermometers
- HOUSEHOLD: batteries, camping gas cylinders, cleaning products, drain opener, flourescent lightbulbs, garden chemicals, kerosene, poisons, pool & hot tub chemicals, shoe polish, solvents, and thermostats
- MISC ITEMS: e-cigarettes, musical greeting cards, pepper spray and smoke detectors



SPECIAL DISPOSAL



GOT OLD PAINT LAYING AROUND?

(Fees apply) For a lot of bulky items, consider our debris box service.

- Carpet & carpet padding (rolls no bigger than 6' long x 18" wide
- ✓ Untreated wood
